- Winter Extensive refurbishment and re-wire. Her original twin 175 HP Perkins' diesels 1993/1994 were replaced with Volvo TMD41 engines. Interior rebuilt by Michael Dennett of Laleham.

 - 1996 Taken to Guernsey, the Channel Islands. Now owned by Michael Mortimer.
