

I prepare the floor of the dinette seats which, as you can see in the photo in the previous post, is raised above the floorboard.

Furthermore, the floor corresponding to the driver's seat is higher than that of the seats towards the table.

I use 3x1 mm mahogany strips.

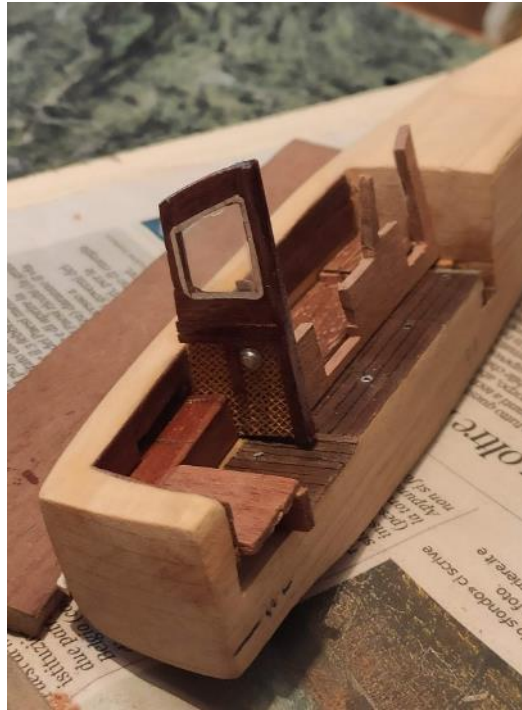


I cut it to length, smooth it with fine sandpaper and then I place it in the dinette without gluing to check that everything fits together



Before continuing, I do another dry test with the pieces of the cockpit and dinette. Everything seems to fall into place without major problems. I'll do the detailed finishing in a later stage before proceeding with gluing the parts





Now that I have verified that the measurements are correct, I can proceed further and glue the side of the seats to the floor. In the parts that will not be visible as will be covered by the seat, I place a thick to facilitate gluing. All that remains is to wait for the glue to dry ... ..
