	Main engine Chrysler Crown 6 cylinder, 58-103 HP @1600-3200 RPM into a 17" x 18" prop through a 2:1 reduction drive.
	Auxiliary Engine Parsons/Ford C4M, 10-24 HP @ 1500-3000 RPM direct into a 9" x 10" prop.
