- 1994 Owned by Martin & Anita Brown of Scunthorpe.
Original 2.5 BMC diesels (EX4 Taxi type) were replaced by HT6.354 Perkins removed from [CARICIAN](#).
- 1997 Sunk.
Rebuilt by Stanilands of Hull. Moored on the River Trent.
