Title: Half hull – Etoile de Paris

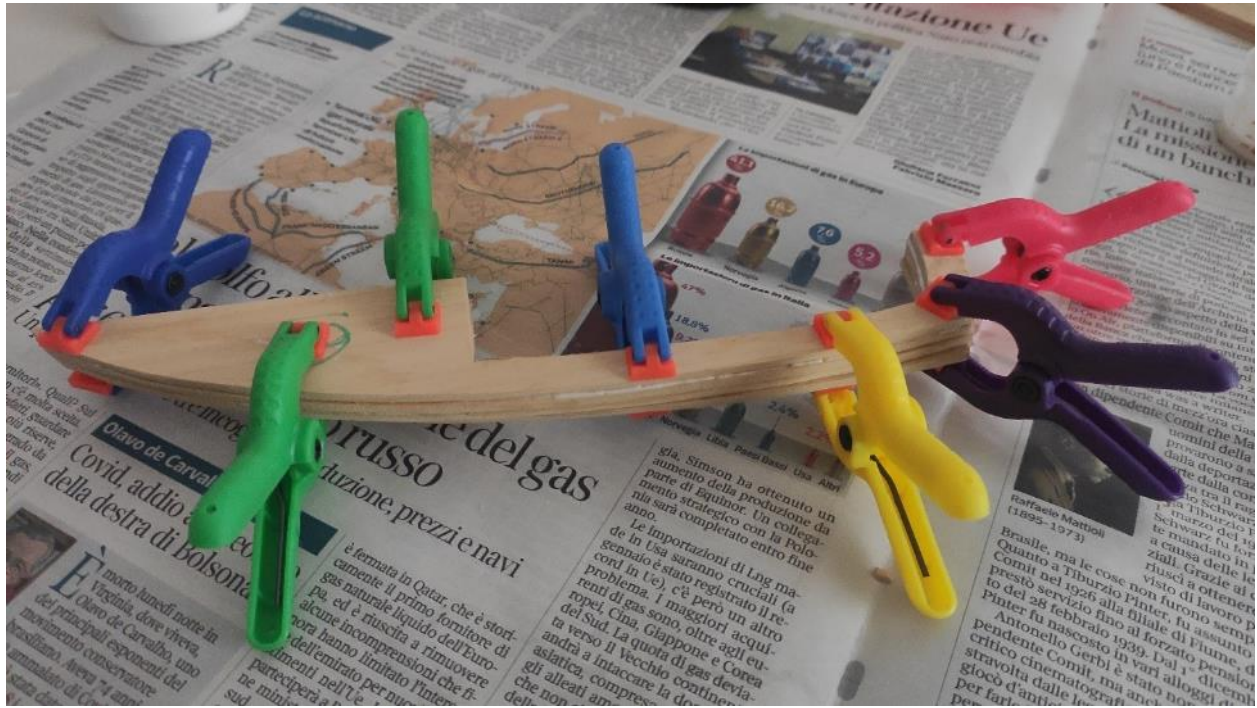

After purchasing a more professional set of clamps, I proceeded to glue together sequentially the sections I've previously assembled, in order to ensure a greater accuracy of the whole.

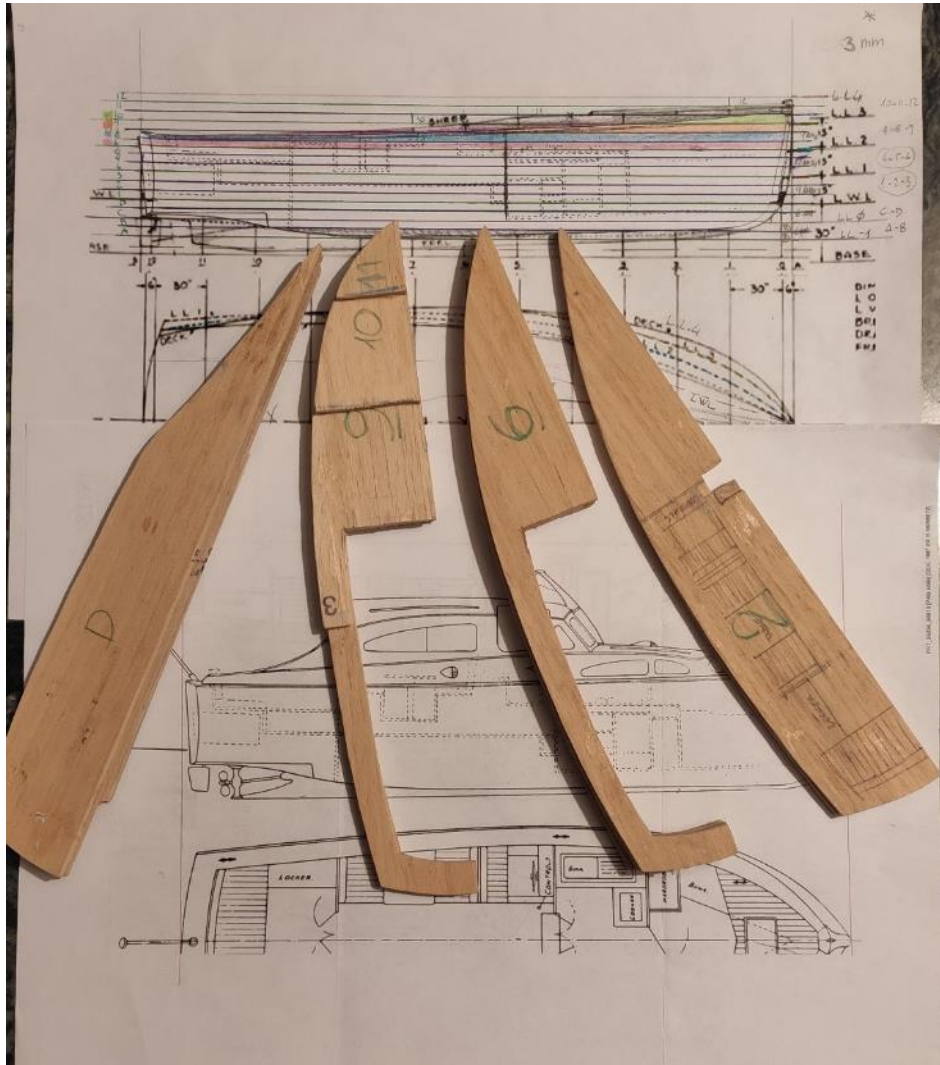
Here is the complete hull



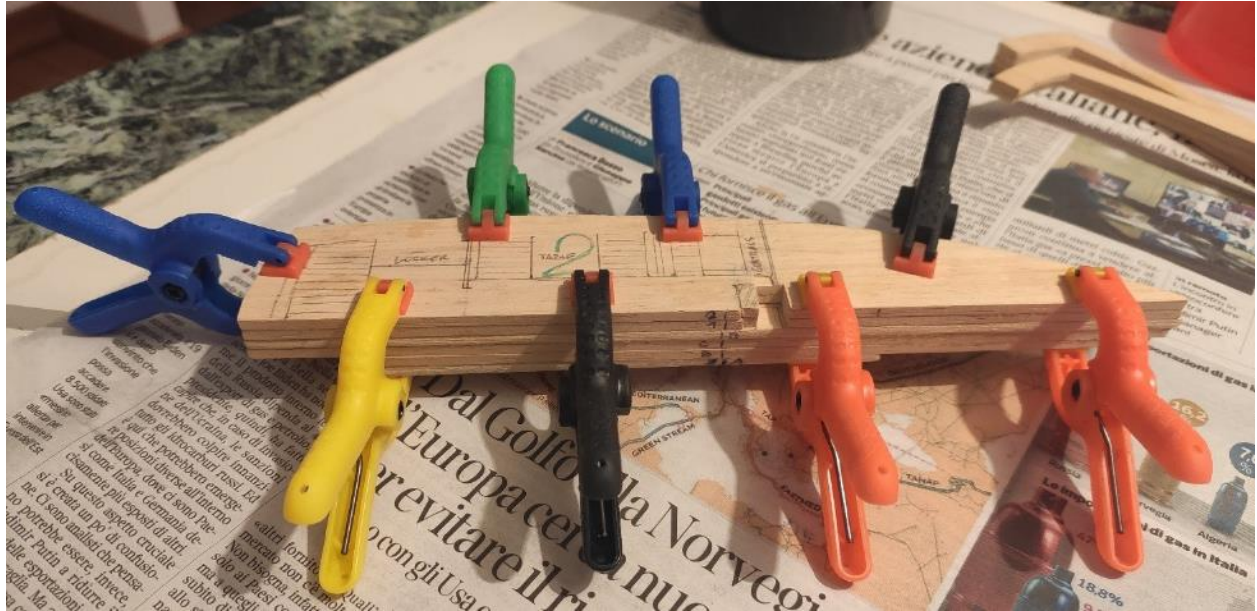
And the two parts of the topside with the shape of the cockpit and dinette, glued separately



Once the glue has dried, this is how the 4 parts of the hull thus obtained look like.



I refined with sandpaper the step of the floor towards the lower deck and joined sections 1 and 2 of the floor with those of the hull.



I then joined the 2 parts of the topside made previously.



Now the glue has dried and the 2 parts of the hull are ready for the next refining phase where I'll give the boat an accurate shape.

I will work first on the inside of the cockpit and dinette and then I'll join it to the other part in order to have the complete hull.



In the meantime, I slightly lowered the level of the cockpit floor as it is on the original boat. This step also acts as a stop for the door that separates the cockpit and dinette.



While waiting for the glue to dry during the assembly phase, I started projecting the internal part consisting of seats, doors and a table, designing the various pieces that I will make with the
